GUIDING METRICS - WHY AND HOW

Goal: Reopen as safely and soon as possible

The Hamline Church Council will monitor data and update recommendations for reopening.

The data from our guiding metrics will change over time and our church experiences and plans will change accordingly.

GUIDING METRICS WHERE DO WE LOOK?

The Hamline Church United Methodist COVID Task Force will use the following metrics to guide our decisions for reopening:

OUTDOOR WORSHIP BEGINS JUNE 20

- Sundays at 10:00am on the Front Lawn
- Service is live streamed to hamlinechurch.org/live-stream, on Facebook and YouTube. It is available on demand, to watch online.
- If raining, people stay home; worship leaders livestream the service from the Sanctuary without a congregation.

What do we need from YOU?

- Stay home if sick or exposed
- Practice physical distancing
- Masks are optional outside and required indoors.

WHERE SHOULD YOU SIT FOR WORSHIP?

- Allow distance between households or pods
- Fully vaccinated people may sit together with friends whom they know are also fully vaccinated
- People encouraged to bring their own chairs or blankets; use of Hamline Church chairs is allowed, but chairs will be set up as people who need them arrive
- Greeters help people find places to sit that are an appropriate distance

SINGING FOR WORSHIP

• Musicians at least 10 feet away from congregation

SAFETY PROCEDURES FOR OUTDOOR WORSHIP

- Bulletins and offering buckets placed on a table for people to pick up and deposit donations
- Hand sanitizer available
- No communion
- No refreshments served
- Children will begin in worship with families, then they will be invited to participate in the Summer in the Garden program. Summer in the Garden will be led by vaccinated Hamline staff, volunteers and interns. You may participate with your child if you'd like.
- Bathrooms open; custodian will make sure that bathrooms are disinfected before Sunday morning

CHURCH GROUP GATHERINGS

Worship, of course, is not the only way we come together. For all the other times – meetings, programming, practices, and more – we have broad guidelines for you.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL GATHERINGS

- Face covering/mask required indoors
- Stay home if sick or exposed
- Physical distancing
