### KIDS TODAY

Children in prek-6th grade can join staff and volunteers for Sacred Studio (our spiritual formation time) after the children's moment. Please pick your child up at the end of worship.

- Prek-k will be in Room 10, 1st-2nd grade in Room 7, 3rd-4th grade downstairs in the Parlor.
- 5th and 6th grade will stay in worship together, then gather in Room 6 after the sermon.

### Are children welcome here?

Yes! Children are always welcome in worship. Coloring and reading supplies are available near the Commons doors, and in the narthex. We have a quieter space available to all in the chapel off the narthex.

### Where is the nursery?

Children 5 and under are welcome in the nursery, located in Room 8 in the upstairs Sunday school hallway. Our service is streamed in the nursery, if you would like to join your child. Nursing spaces available on the rocking chairs in the sanctuary, in the Frolic room (8), or in the chapel off the narthex.
