Job Summary:

Hamline Church United Methodist is seeking students to explore ministry opportunities at Hamline Church. Internships are crafted to fit individual interests and gifts/skills. The internship includes opportunities to develop leadership, explore Christian community, and deepen one's spiritual journey.

There will be weekly reflection meetings with the Associate Pastor of Spiritual formation as interns get to know the congregation, participate in events, lead in worship, reflect theologically on scripture, discern their role in ministries, and deepen their faith.

Over the course of the internship, each intern will develop and lead a project that will extend their leadership, skills, interests, and faith formation. Areas of focus might be arts and music, communication, social justice, community bread oven, sustainability/green team, youth and children, worship and spirituality.

The goal is for interns to become integrated into the life of a congregation, explore various forms of leadership, reflect on their spiritual paths, learn new skills, and experience the vitality of Christian community.
