Today's worship is led by the 20 hamline Church youth and adults who served in Harlan County, KY, July 19 - 26, 2025 as part of ASP. ASP brings thousands of volunteers from around the country to rural Central Appalachia to repair homes for low-income families. Since 1969, they've made homes warmer, safer, and drier for families and provided transformational service experiences for volunteers. Each year, more than 15,000 volunteers serve with ASP, providing critical repairs for more than 350 families.
